- Need evidence to communicate on progress of FP towards delivering impact towards all types of stakeholders, incl. citizens

ACCOUNTABILITY

- Need to deliver on monitoring & evaluations requirements from FP Regulation & Better Regulation
- Need evidence to demonstrate value for money of EU R&I investments

LEARNING

- Need evidence on what the FP delivers and doesn't deliver, why & how - to take corrective actions
- Need evidence to identify current and future needs & translate high-level objectives into concrete actions





Multidisciplinary, transnational networks make research more impactful

Definition

positive effects that go beyond what would have been achieved by national or local players acting alone

EU funded mobility and training reinforce human capital

Encourage more effective public-private partnerships

Distinctive EU funded research doesn't displace national funding

Information sharing increases EU competitiveness

Dissemination policies create new market opportunities

Create evidence for policy-making (e.g. IPCC reports)
